**Job Summary**: Oversees all POS and QuickBooks activities, purchase orders, receiving vouchers, and accounts payable and receivable tasks. Responsible for administering inventory.

# Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following (other duties may be assigned):

- Completes all accounts payable duties from filling in Purchase Orders to creating and Receiving Vouchers and cutting checks in a timely fashion.
- Ensure we receive whatever discounts from vendors are available.
- Ensures that all merchandise is checked in properly and received into inventory in an efficient, timely manner. Make sure everything is labeled with a price tag and item number. Submits credit requests to a vendor for any damaged merchandise in a timely fashion.
- Ensures that all merchandise is priced accordingly to proper margins by department.
- Responsible for performing intermittent inventory counts throughout the year.
- Makes inventory quantity and cost adjustments as necessary.
- Performs administrative duties such as ordering store and office supplies, sending, and receiving mail, etc.
- Performs Accounts Receivable duties such as Sales Order balance collection.
- Works closely with vendors to orchestrate shipments and deliveries of merchandise.
- Performs other duties as needed.

## Education and/or Work Experience:

High school diploma or GED required/Associate's degree preferred. Horticulture knowledge and retail garden center highly desired. Minimum 2 years of experience using QuickBooks and POS software.

### Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

Extensive computer skills including QuickBooks, POS, Excel, and Word. Extremely taskoriented and organized. Some accounting skills are necessary including understanding margins and budgets. Able to use a forklift.

### **Physical Job Requirements:**
